The first iteration of the Side-by-Side Program was created with all the Care Team components — personal and financial mentors, a licensed professional counselor, and a staff member to guide the way.

Three major annual events were added to the ministry: the Known Seen Loved Celebration, the Hope in Healing grief retreat, and a fall fundraising gala.



The Mission and Vision statements were refined to reflect the growth and impact that 431 Ministries continues to have, and the Re:Store Me Assessment was formally launched!

A Note From Our Director

If you had asked me five years ago what I thought 431 Ministries would look like in 2024, I would have cast a vision of a place for single moms. I was passionate about the issues I saw, and the life change I knew was possible. But I would have limited our reach to a single set of rooms and beds, chairs and meals, jobs and childcare spots.

I had no idea how much more the Lord had in mind or the exponential impact that would occur when I released my initial vision. And that was one of the hardest lessons of 2023.

My singular focus on a building, single mothers, and what growth should look like shifted this year. The Lord established a team—a board of directors, staff, and a community of men and women who have walked a similar journey—and used them to show me the larger impact He wanted to have through 431 Ministries.

For the past five years, we have been known as "the single mom's ministry." But we are so much more than that. Today, we get to daily offer opportunities of hope and a plan to ANY woman who has been through a hardship or is facing one: in widowhood, through grief experiences, after the loss of a spouse to divorce, in single motherhood, after relational abuse/abandonment, living in post-sobriety or facing a place of uncertainty. And so this fall, our vision was refined to reflect that WE ARE A PLACE WHERE ALL WOMEN ARE KNOWN. SEEN. LOVED.™


So, as we enter 2024, my passion will not decrease. In fact, the urgency around these issues has increased tenfold and empowering the community to take part in a solution is critical. So my request this year is the same one that Paul had in Ephesians 6:19-20: "Pray also for me, that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the gospel, for which I am an ambassador in chains. Pray that I may declare it fearlessly, as I should."

The Lord's hand of favor has been on this ministry from the beginning, and it is humbling and an honor to be on the front lines. We don't want to do it without you, so this is your invitation.

Needs of Middle TN

Women who are in a difficult situation whether by their choice or not—need education, skills, and a community not only to help them overcome current challenges, but to avoid similar situations in the future.



The Presence of Grief



specifically selected to help women know they are not alone and encourage them to participate in our global KSL Community. Grief is a common thread through each petal of 431 Ministries. Whether it's the loss of a spouse, shifting expectations of a future, or coming to recognize abuse, the hardships we serve come with working through seasons of grief.

The Hope in the Valley Conference added in 2023 aimed to do exactly that. It unwrapped some of the complexities of grief and reminded attendees that emotions, including grief, are a gift from the Lord. A community of women came together to learn and grow, and be reminded that worship, gratitude and surrender are part of healing.

The Conference works in tandem with the Hope in

Healing Retreat as well as other Re:Store Resources to remind all women that grief and joy can coexist, and each new season can make it easier to bear.

When a woman who has been through hardship learns how to grieve well—be it a person, a situation, a future, or even simply expectations—only then can she learn to heal well.


